You can have the name of any deceased Maine Firefighter put on these Plaques by filling out this form. One form per name. These plaques of deceased firefighters names is a mobile part of the Maine Firefighters Memorial that is erected at the State Capital. It is set up so it can travel around the State has it can visit local fire departments, County Meetings, or any fire related meetings or memorial ceremonies throughout our State. It is proudly displayed at our annual Firefighter Conventions and at the annual Memorial Service held in Augusta every October.

The names on the plaque must be of a deceased firefighter and it does include both Line of Duty and Non-Line of Duty deaths. The firefighters on these plaques do not have to be Maine State Federation of Firefighters members only. The firefighter could be Volunteer, Pain on Call, Auxiliary or Career. They could have worked for Municipalities, the Federal Government, the State Government, such as our Forest Rangers, or private Industry such as the fire crew at Bath Iron Works.

The cost of adding a name to these plaques is \$30.00. The funds raised by each name is used to help in the up keep and maintenance of the Firefighters Memorial in Augusta.
